

# Simple Scrubby

## Supplies:

G hook  
yarn needle  
worsted weight yarn  
(cotton for face scrubby,  
acrylic or nylon for dishes)

## Stitches Used:

slip stitch = sl  
chain = ch  
single crochet = sc  
double crochet = dc

## Gauge:

rows 1-4 = 4 inches



## Row 1:

leaving a tail approximately 6 inches long, ch 3, 12 dc in first ch, join with sl in first dc;

## Row 2:

ch 2 (does not count as first dc), 2 dc in each stitch around, join with sl in first dc;

## Row 3:

ch 2 (does not count as first dc), [1 dc in next stitch, 2 dc in next stitch] around, join with sl in first dc;

## Row 4:

ch 1 (does not count as first sc), [sc, ch 1] in each stitch around, join, fasten off;

## Finishing:

with yarn needle, weave tail from starting chain through back of stitches around center, pulling tight to close any remaining space;  
weave in finishing end.
